Guest Speaker
J.R. introduced Bill Ridgway, Director of

Economic Development for the City of Euless. Bill opened with thanking everyone for all their volunteer work and indicated that the single most important commodity in the city were its volunteers. He thanked everyone for what they do.

He gave special recognition to our Volunteer of the Year - Faye Stinneford. There were many questions asked and answered about different areas of Euless. There is a good industrial opportunity south of Hwy.10. The Krispy Creme building was sold to RSI; they work in the area of airport simulations. A lot of our industrial business is aircraft related. We will have a Chili's at 157 and Glade as well as Lowes. Toro renovated the old Sutherland property. They sell lawnmowers commercially, but residents could get a deal on a used one. The City is aware of the need for a grocery store south of Hwy.183, and they have been working on this. Hwy.10 is starting to develop slowly. This should be finished by 2014. Reynolds asphalt bought the old Kmart building.

Income that the city receives from gas rights are not included in the Budget; profits go back to the entities that own the land. The hotel next to Gators is gutted and ready to

go; they are seeking hotel company to renovate. In the meantime, Gators has a one year lease based on what happens to the hotel. Euless has sold no surface rights. At Euless Town Center, a fun center named Incredible Pizza will be built. It is family-oriented and should open next February or March. You will pay one fee to enter - various games, activities and food will be available. The city is actively looking for a nice sit down restaurant. At this point, all questions were answered and we adjourned for a short break before we resumed the business meeting.

Minutes Approval

Tim Stinneford made a motion to approve the minutes. Geri Sorg seconded. Passed.

Treasurer's Report

Teresia passed out a report. She is unable to get the formula that is programmed to work correctly. At this time we will not vote on the report, and Debbie Wright offered to assist Teresia in correcting the formulas.

Christmas Provider

Leah Benoit has been given a family for us. Right now the details are not known, but she will be speaking with them and get the details to the shoppers. We do know that the family consists of a father, mother and two children - one son and one daughter. They live in Euless. The shoppers are Sharon Finnegan, Karen Duncan and Betty Overstreet. Our budget for this is \$400.00 unless we receive monies from donations.

Old Business

Ballots for voting on the by-law revisions were passed out to all present. Everyone voted. Forms were collected and Committee went to count votes. The revised by-laws were approved and the method for voting for officers starting next year was changed. Only members present at the November meeting can vote for new officers.

Fundraising

Debbie Wright moved that we not pursue a casino night fund raiser; Geri Sorg seconded the motion and it was passed. We will not pursue a Casino Night at this time. We do need some type fund raiser. Without Arbor Daze we will not have the Budget we need. Everyone was asked to think of any fund raising activities that we could consider.

J.R. gave the ECPAAA a check for \$500.00 from Wal-Mart. He also mentioned that he has been trying to get gift cards to help with our purchases for the Christmas Provider family.

We will have our gift wrapping fund raiser at Bass Pro. J.R. circulated sign-up sheets with many slots open.



John Woodall now has a can crusher and he has approximately 100 lbs. of cans to take for recycling. Remember to bring your cans to the meeting; or, if you have a bunch, you can leave them in the area behind the PD. There is a container for this purpose. We are also taking your empty computer printer ink cartridges for recycling.

We need a fundraiser to fund our Budget. We received monies from VHA and Verizon on behalf of Leah Benoit and Rose-Marie Stevens. We have our gift wrapping at Bass Pro in December. We could supplement our income with brick orders. As mentioned in the newsletter, we will be sending in a brick order in December; the next order will be placed in June. The members were asked to consider ordering bricks as gifts.

Parade of Lights

The Euless Parade of Lights is scheduled for December 2nd. We need volunteers, and a sign-up sheet was circulated. Debbie Wright volunteered to drive one of the COP cars.

Nominating Committee

Lou Baum advised that the candidates for next year were published in the November newsletter. Everyone was sent a ballot. Ballots must be postmarked no later than December 3rd to be included in the voting.

First Vice President's Report

J.R. shared an article from the Fort Worth Star-Telegram about our organization and its nomination for volunteer organization of the year. It was a very nice article. In the meantime, Lou Baum has turned in paperwork for national recognition of our volunteer hours. We are still one of the top organizations with volunteer hours.

J.R. wanted everyone to know that his wife Kay was doing well after her stint surgery. She wanted to thank everyone for their thoughts and prayers.

President's Report

Rosemarie advised that we need a Budget Committee and she will work with the com-

mittee to form the 2007 budget. The members are Karen Duncan, J.R. Goad, Geri Sorg and Jerrie Keller.

Police Liaison Report

Sgt. David Chaney had questionnaires from the City available and asked that we complete and return them. A new CPA class has been scheduled to start January 4th. Sgt. Chaney advised that Officer Parker is looking at all CPA applications. Please refer friends and neighbors who are interested. A new CERT class date will be announced later.

Anyone who needs a COP shirt or jacket should give Sgt. Chaney their sizes, and he will order them. We have a new shirt design; they will be ordered through Julie Watkins at Stitch 'N Tyme.

Eight CERT members participated in the CERT Olympics held in September. We only received a three-week notice since we had not participated in this event before. It was an all-day event, and everyone agreed they had a great time. Awards were presented afterward. Cpl. James Gordon reminded everyone that after Thanksgiving we have a lot of parking lot robberies and recommended that we be especially aware of our surroundings during this time.

Sgt. Chaney also reported that alum Joyce Humphries was honored as president of the apartment association. It was reported that there has been a lot of vandalism in the cemetery east of 360. Though it is in Euless, it falls with the jurisdiction of the DFW Police, and he will advise them of the problem.

We need a committee for setting up a light lunch for officers on duty on Christmas Day. We have a Budget of \$300.00. Betty Overstreet and Erelene Hill have agreed to take this project.

Next month, on December 19, we will be wrapping presents for our Christmas Provider family. Pizza will be provided.

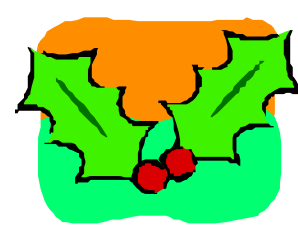
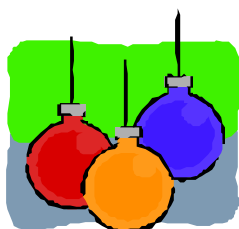
