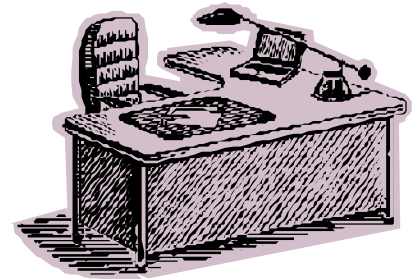
comments about you from those who toured our facility. Your commitment is inspiring! Thanks again.

Strengthening Euless CERT***Disaster Medical Operations - Treatment***

As we refresh our CERT skill set through independent learning, please re-read **Unit Four, Disaster Medical Operations -- PART TWO**. Then, please spend 30 minutes thinking through the following CERT Challenge.

It is 11 o'clock am on a Wednesday in the summer. Lots of families are at the Dr. Pepper Star Center enjoying public skating time. A teenage prank turns dangerous when two boys ignite a small pipe bomb in the center. At least twenty children are hurt in the explosion.

EPD activates CERT and sets up a treatment area at the Parks of Texas Star. You're assigned to the medical tent as a flood of injured kids are being carried in. How would you treat the following patients?

1. A 10-year old boy with a large second degree burn covering his abdomen and chest.
2. A 7-year-old girl with deep facial lacerations around her eyes and forehead.
3. A 20-year-old man with an amputated hand that is actively bleeding and third-degree burns.
4. A 5-year-old girl with an ice skate blade impaled into her lower leg.
5. A 12-year-old boy with a closed arm fracture and burns on his face and neck.
6. A 15-year-old girl with a femur fracture where the bone is exposed.
7. An 8-year-old boy with a bloody nose and facial lacerations.
8. A 10-year-old girl who has hypothermia from being wedged under a bleacher on the ice rink.

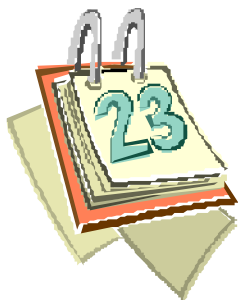
