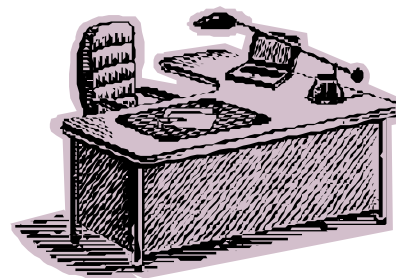

CERT Organization

This exercise is about CERT Organization, pages 6-1 through 6-20 in the CERT manual. Please read this section and think through the following situation. Remember, safety is paramount and CERTs always work in teams, never alone.

A fire breaks out at Lowes and spreads across the entire shopping center on 121 and Glade Road at 2 pm on a Monday. Fire and police resources are at full capacity and EPD activates CERT. You are first on the scene and set up a command post in the nearby Chili's parking lot.

You are the Incident Commander. You'll need: a runner, planning teams (to collect and compile documentation), logistics teams (to locate resources, services and supplies), and operations teams (to include fire suppression, medical, and search and rescue).

The following CERTs arrive on-site. What is your strategy? How will you set priorities? How will you manage and deploy these resources? What tasks will you give each person taking into account their strengths and weaknesses?

40 y.o. male -- physically fit, carpenter, volunteer coach

35 y.o. male -- physically fit, physician

30 y.o. female -- physically fit, small frame, nurse

55 y.o. male -- physical limitations, engineer & architect

42 y.o. female -- physically fit, stay-home mom

60 y.o. male -- physical limitations, allergic to smoke, drives a pickup

28 y.o. female -- 6 months pregnant, secretary

70 y.o. male -- physically active, runner, army training

45 y.o. female -- physically fit, accountant, volunteer girl scout

32 y.o. male -- physical limitations, disabled Gulf War vet, lifetime Eulless resident

50 y.o. female -- physically fit, wears glasses, restaurant manager

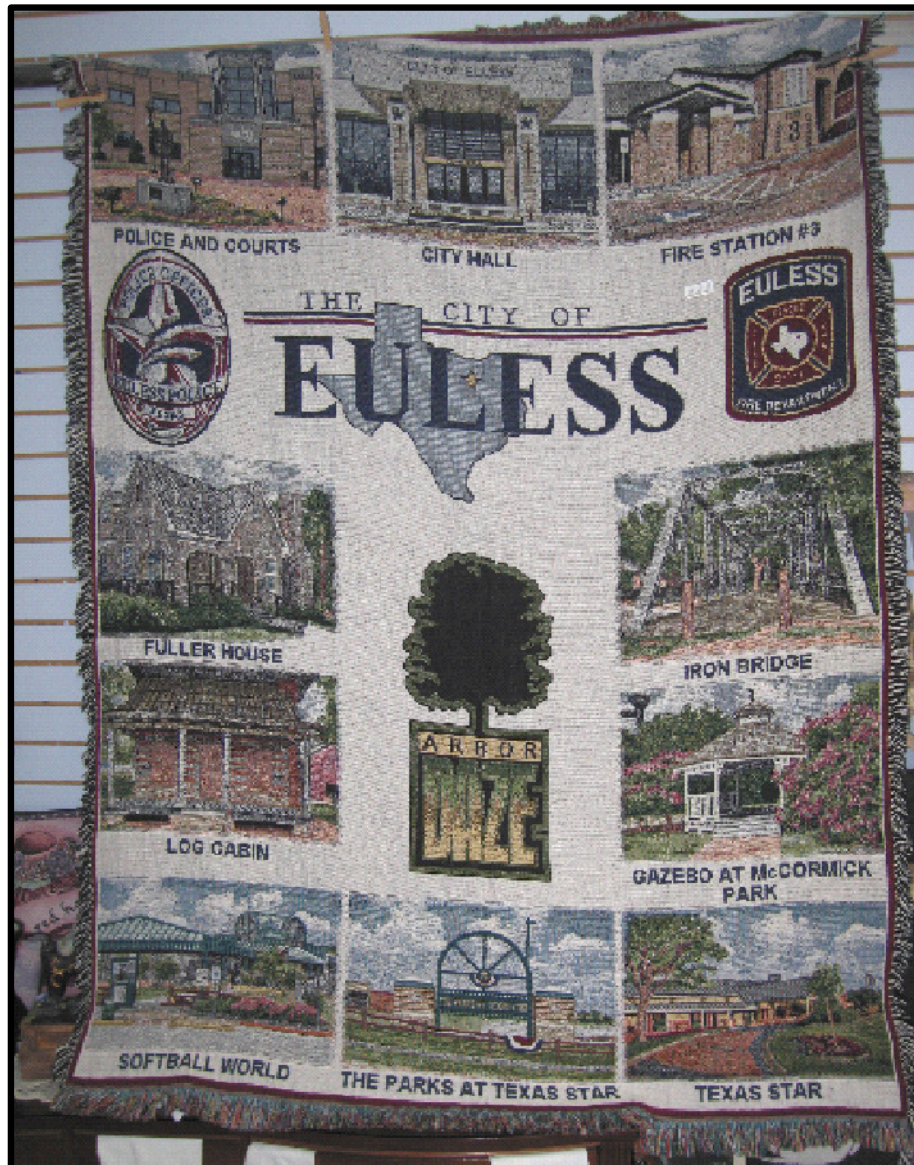
Lastly, remember to print forms 6-A-1 to 6-A-7 and keep them in your CERT backpack in case you are the first CERT to arrive at a scene or you are selected the Incident Commander. Much like boy scouts we must always be prepared.
